## SHIPYARD REIMERSWAAL ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

It is the policy of Shipyard Reimerswaal to build, repair, convert, and modify ships and conduct related dock activities in a safe, healthy, and environmentally responsible way. The Environmental policy is part of the overall company policy, but as a sub-policy, it is inextricably linked to all aspects of the business and is carried out with the same commitment as the realisation of other business objectives.

### Environmental business objectives of Shipyard Reimerswaal

Shipyard Reimerswaal wants to know, manage and minimise the effect (as low as reasonably achievable) on the environment caused by their activities, with ultimate goals:

- Zero environmental incidents.
- Work is carried out within the legal boundaries set in the environmental permit.
- Achieve a constant reduction of the CO<sub>2</sub> emission in the yard by approx. 10% by the year 2030.

The mentioned goals can only be achieved when the managing board, employees, temporary workers and third parties are familiar with this Environmental policy and take responsibility for it. Annually, this Environmental policy will be reviewed and adapted if required.

## OUR LEGAL RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING ENVIRONMENT

Shipyard Reimerswaal is by law responsible for the implementation of the below-mentioned environmental responsibilities as embedded in the prevailing environmental permit :

#### 3 main top-down responsibilities (management, supervisory personnel):

1. Create and maintain an environmental safe workplace;
2. Provide instructions & training on environmental issues;
3. Supervise & correct.

#### 3 main bottom-up responsibilities (all employees & sub-contractors):

1. Follow procedures & instructions;
2. Report environmental hazardous situations;
3. Stop work when in direct environmental danger.

## PRINCIPLES & REQUIREMENTS

This policy has been established to prevent environmental accidents. When accidents occur, they should be dealt with adequately.

Laws and regulations regarding environmental requirements are known and reviewed and will be complied with.

Environmental aspects are considered in the selection of suppliers and subcontractors.


Encourage customers to follow SWR's environmental policy when they visit the yard.
